Plan A1 and Plan 2	The applicant must hold a bachelor's degree in engineering, science, technology, industrial technical education, medicine, dentistry, pharmacy, or a related field, which have to be approved by the program's administration committee.	
If the applicant does not meet the qualifications, it is at the discretion of the Curriculum Management Committee.

Scholarships:

1. Scholarships supporting research and study for graduate students to conduct thesis, dissertation or independent study

For master students: up to 30,000 Baht/person For doctoral students: up to 30,000 Baht/person

2. Award for publishing research work

Doctoral students who have published research work or part of a research work that has been published or accepted for publication in an international journal indexed in SCIE database, starting from the first or second quartile, with at least 2 articles or more (paying only for the second article onwards) and the article must have been accepted before notifying the end of the study. The student must be the first author and will receive a prize of 20,000 Baht. Master students who have research papers or parts of research papers that have been published or accepted for publication in international journals indexed in the SCIE database, with at least 1 article, and the work must have been accepted before the end of the student's program. The student must be the first author. If the article is in the 1st or 2nd quartile, the student will receive a prize of 20,000 Baht. If the article is in the 3rd or 4th quartile, the student will receive a prize of 10,000 Baht.
